Ages: 10-15 yrs. or 5th-9th Grade Boys & Girls

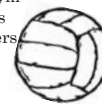

Students will handle rocks and minerals and perform identification tests. Students will test their knowledge with rock and mineral bingo. We will discuss types of rocks and minerals and their uses. Students will be identifying various rocks and minerals, learn about moh's hardness scale, density, fluorescence, crystals, and more!

2nd Class: Fire Under the Earth-Volcanoes
